

## Important Scholarship Information

Although scholarships are awarded at the end of the senior year, they are awarded on the accumulation of all four years of high school participation.

1. **Get Good Grades!** The best way to earn points on your rodeo scholarship form is to maintain good grades throughout all of your high school years.
  2. **Get Involved!** You are awarded points for participation in activities outside of rodeo. Every high school club, community, and civic activity you participate in during four years of high school counts on your scholarship application.
  3. **Get Leadership Experience!** Points are awarded for offices held on all levels of rodeo involvement: High school club, district, state, and national offices. Points are even awarded for being an event director during your district's rodeos.
  4. **Get Competitive Experience!** The more events you choose to compete in, the more experience you will receive with the sport of rodeo; and, the more points you will receive on your scholarship application!
- Plan now for future education careers, goals, and objectives.
  - Everyone who competes in high school rodeo is eligible to apply for a rodeo scholarship.
  - Scholarships will be awarded to those students who have earned the highest scores on the application.
  - Scholarship money will be paid directly to the educational institution upon proof of registration. Any accredited educational institution is acceptable, including technical schools, vo-tech programs, as well as traditional college and universities. For example, accredited beauty schools, welding schools, or even certified farrier schools are eligible for scholarship money.
  - Scholarship money cannot be held over and must be used within that academic year. For example, students entering the military or serving church missions cannot hold the money for future use.
  - Get Going!!!! It really does pay to do your best in school, in the practice pen, in the community, and in the rodeo arena!

## Attention Graduating Seniors!!

- Enclosed in your rodeo entry packet is the form to apply for this year's scholarship money. Start filling out your application now! May gets extremely hectic, and it is very stressful to leave important details until the last minute.
- Your completed application is due to your club advisor at the first Oakley rodeo. If anything is not complete, this will give you time to make the corrections.
